47TH IPS NATIONAL CONFERENCE, RAIPUR, CHHATTISGARH- EXPLORE, INTEGRATE AND EVOLVE

IPS Chhattisgarh Branch proudly hosted the 47th IPS National Conference at the capital city Raipur from 28 November-01 December,2019 with surgical precision to impart an unique learning experience to an overwhelming 2000 odd delegates from all over India. Delegates witnessed four days of scientific deliberations, brainstorming, innovations, cultural extravaganza and reconnect with teachers, colleagues, friends and students.
